Uniting WA welcomes the relaunch of White Ribbon Australia

The return of White Ribbon Australia is an important step for Australians who stand for a just society.

Uniting commends Communicare for relaunching White Ribbon Australia under the leadership of Brad Chilcott as Executive Director.

The White Ribbon movement plays an important role in addressing gendered family and domestic violence in our community.

Reshaping the organisation from an awareness platform to one which is more focussed on meaningful and impactful advocacy is a welcome and timely move, says Uniting CEO Amanda Hunt.

"Right now, many community services agencies are facing unprecedented pressures to keep women and children safe in challenging times.
