

ILP Eligibility

To be eligible for the ILP prospective tenants must:

- 1. Be 18 years of age and under 65 years of age at point of entry of the program;
- 2. Be diagnosed with a mental health issue that:
 - a. has complex impacts on their lives which is exacerbated by housing instability
 - b. affects their capacity to obtain and maintain stable housing
- 3. Have a willingness to access support as required;
- 4. Be able to live independently in the community with support;
- 5. At the time of referral be receiving clinical support provided by either a GP, private mental health practitioner or the public mental health service;
- 6. Meet the eligibility criteria for public housing. This includes:
 - a. Be an Australian citizen or permanent resident
 - b. Live in Western Australia and receive an income here
 - c. Be within the income and asset eligibility threshold for social housing
 - d. Not own property or land
